Parent Declaration - Funding Forms

All Nursery children (15hrs and 30hrs) to allow school to apply for funding each half term;

- 30hrs codes apply / re-check with HMRC by 30th August 2023
- Include all information including NHS Number / 30hrs code

Early years Pupil Premium check is made automatically by school and we will let you know if you're eligible.

Return by 7th July at latest.

Absence

Illness / Medical

Absences reported via email / phone by 8.30am or 12.10pm each

day that child is ill.

Medical appointments require evidence e.g. hospital letter, texts, appointments cards etc.

All other absences

Families to request absence via Term Time Absence Request Form available via school office.

Late children are registered via the school office – please call / email so we know where the child is

First calls will be made by Office Team from 9am or 12.30pm to understand whereabouts of child and reason for absence.



Medicine & First Aid

Medicine - property of parents and you give us permission to administer to children via a Request to Administer Medicine Form

- Pain relief or antibiotics provided by families
- 4 doses or more a day
- Clear instructions on medicine label

Medical needs including asthma pumps / Epi Pens

Families meet with SENCo to draw up Health Care Plan

We don't hold pain relief in school All staff are first aid trained, 3 staff are qualified Paediatric First Aiders All injuries are reported to families via an accident slip Serious injuries inc. all head bumps are also reported via phone calls
